Meeting with Onsite Wastewater Systems Installers of Manitoba (OWSIM)

On June 3, 2017, representatives from WCOWMA met with the Board and members of OWSIM to discuss the potential to amalgamate under the Manitoba Onsite Wastewater Management Association banner.

Discussion centered on the advantages of amalgamation such as increased opportunities to provide training to onsite wastewater practitioners in the province. The potential for training includes certification training, site and soils evaluation, mound installation field training and other practical continuing education programs. Derek Smith from Manitoba Conservation also attended the meeting and outlined proposed changes to the education requirements in the Province.

Another focus of the stakeholders present is the development and delivery of a public education program that would help homeowners understand the value and importance of a properly designed, installed and maintained onsite system. The decision on whether or not to join forces with WCOWMA has now been put out to the OWSIM membership at large for a vote.
